Camp Leaders

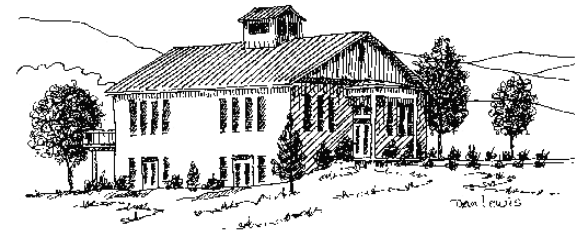
